In November Vicar Mia Crosthwaite begins the second half of her internship at Trinity. She's learned and served the past nine months at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Boise. The second half of her internship here at Trinity will be 30 hours a week, culminating next July. She is supervised by Pastors Meggan Manlove and Gretchen Bingea and guided by a lay internship committee comprised of members from

both congregations. Mia Crosthwaite, a native Idahoan and the founder of the Idaho Discipleship Conference, has been speaking, writing and teaching about living a life following Christ for over twenty years. She has written and spoken locally and nationally, including one book: "Go and Do Likewise, Catholic Social Teaching in Action." She served many years in ministry in the Roman Catholic Diocese of Boise in both parish and diocesan roles including children & youth & adult faith formation, youth & adult events, lobbying, retreat leading, leadership formation, and ministerial training. After joining Shepherd of the Valley (Boise) four years ago, she is now a seminarian at Luther Seminary in St. Paul, MN. She already holds a Master in Pastoral Studies from Loyola University New Orleans. Mia and her husband Brian live the adventure of parenting six biological children and three special needs adopted children, ages 7 to 27. Her family lives in the house her in-laws built in 1973 and run a small raw milk dairy under the brand name, Feathers & Horns.

**Trinity Lutheran Church College
Scholarship Description and
Application 2019 Graduates**

The Trinity Lutheran Church College Scholarship is for graduating high school seniors who are active+ members of Trinity Lutheran Church in Nampa, Idaho. This scholarship must be used at a two-year or four-year accredited college or university or an accredited trade school within the academic year following their high school graduation. It is to be used for tuition, books or other education related fees. This scholarship is supported by the Trinity Lutheran Church (TLC) congregation and the TLC Youth Program. The monetary value* funded by TLC for this scholarship will total \$500. This will be given out or divided between one or more students recommended to the church council by the youth committee for final approval based on their Trinity Lutheran Church College Scholarship Application. Scholarship applications will be available to download on the TLC website- www.nampatrinity.org Applicants must complete the application form and return it to the church office before February 15 of their graduating year. Criteria for award selection will be based on completed application and 2 letters of recommendation. Applicants will be notified by mail in April if they are to receive the award [whole or partial]. Recipients will be recognized at the High School Graduate Recognition Sunday in May.


